FoxT Reporting Manager, an optional enhancement to FoxT Enterprise Access Management solutions, enables organizations to manage audit and compliance reporting in a secure, structured way across security domains. FoxT Reporting Manager can be remotely managed and operated from any configured client via an internet browser.

In addition to simplifying audits and regulatory compliance, FoxT Reporting Manager also boosts administrator productivity with improved views into access control policies. And for security and IT management, consolidated visibility into the status of your access controls across domains facilitates pro-active decision making.

FoxT Reporting Manager's key features include:

- Role-based access to compliance, audit, and operational reporting capabilities
- Delivery of business and operational views into your corporate access control policies and audit log data
- Access to compliance report data is automatically segregated from your operational security environment
- Pre-built set of 60+ standard security reports, appropriate to your FoxT Enterprise Access Management infrastructure
- Ability to review and report on access control policies and data across security domains
 - To meet regulatory requirements, it is common to divide operational security along "Chinese Walls" principles with separate security domains
 - However, from a business perspective, it is important to have visibility across domains at a summary level
 - FoxT Reporting Manager supports data access controls to meet both sets of business imperatives
- Trend graphing enables management to quickly assess system activity (e.g. logins, failed logins)
- Data sets from other on-site databases (for example, asset management) may be integrated with your corporate access controls and audit logs

FoxT Reporting Manager is designed for use in highly scalable, enterprise environments. The two industry-standard components include:

- Web application server platform based on either IBM WebSphere, Oracle Weblogic, or Apache Tomcat
- Database platform based on either Oracle or MySQL Enterprise platforms
